Summary of Recommendations of the South Wonston Village Appraisal

Education

1. The availability of existing evening classes in the Village and surrounding area be better communicated to residents
2. The provision of further additional Adult Evening classes be considered together with the use of local experts to provide tuition

Police service

3. The dissatisfaction with the level of policing in the village be drawn to the attention of the Hampshire Police authority

Utilities

4. That further street lighting be installed in the village especially with regard to Downs Rd

Transport & roads

5. The speed limit in the village should be actively enforced on a regular basis
6. The appropriate authorities be asked to address the hazards caused by inconsiderate parking n Downs Road – outside the School/shop – around the Village Hall – outside the Social club and riding stables
