

Insulate Hampshire

'Insulate Hampshire' is an area based insulation scheme backed by Winchester City Council, Hampshire County Council and ten other district, borough and city councils which was launched with funding from ScottishPower.

The scheme is open to all homeowners and privately renting tenants (subject to landlords' permission) in the Winchester City Council and partner authority districts and is now offering **cavity wall insulation FREE OF CHARGE**.

The installation of **loft insulation FREE OF CHARGE** is also available to homeowners and privately renting tenants who currently have less than 60mm (2 ½ inches) of insulation, subject to a free, no obligation technical survey provided by the scheme.

In some larger properties extra meterage charges may apply.

This offer of **FREE INSULATION** is limited however and ends on **31st March 2012**. It is unlikely to be available again as the current discounts offered to residents comes from CERT (Carbon Energy Reduction Target) funding which the government is stopping at the end of this year.

Insulate Hampshire can also offer rolls of insulation to residents to top up their existing insulation for £49 for a maximum 100m².

Statistics from the Energy Saving Trust estimate installing home insulation can offer savings of over £300 a year based on an average 3 bedroom semi detached house and reduce CO₂ emissions by 1.5 tonnes!
