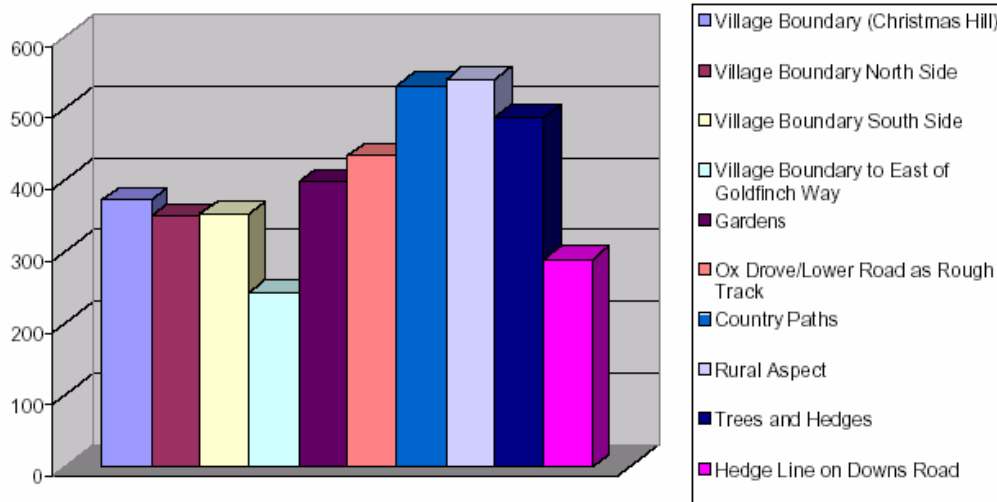
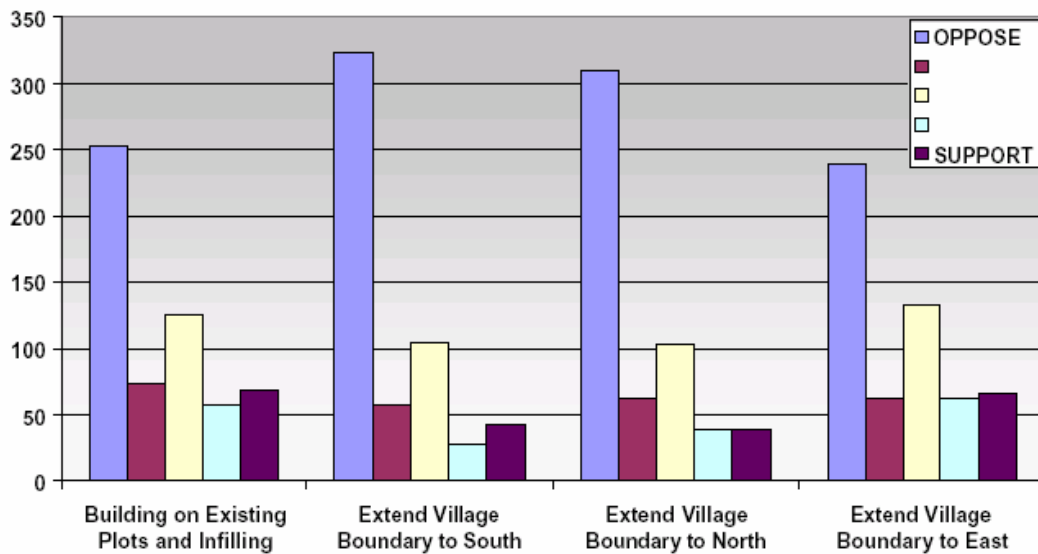


Important Physical Features in South Wonston
